## The Mental and Physical Benefits of Handwriting

## Introduction

The article Why writing by hand beats typing for thinking and learning by Jonathon Lambert discussed many of the benefits of writing by hand as opposed to typing on a computer. In class we summarized five key benefits to writing by hand. For this assignment, you will explore these benefits in more detail and reflect on how they personally impact your learning and thinking processes. You can earn a maximum of five points of extra credit for completing this assignment.

## The Task

- 1. First, choose any assignment that you would normally complete using a computer.
- 2. Next, write out the assignment by hand either in a notebook, on a sheet of paper, or even on a whiteboard.
- 3. Now, complete the assignment using the computer as directed.
- 4. Finally, reflect on how initially working through the assignment on paper impacted the process in terms of the five key points made in class.

## **Formatting**
